It's an easy, practical and economical way to improve your profits, while fulfilling environmental safeguarding.

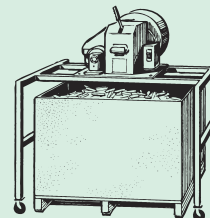
Recycling used strap

Polyester strapping, made from polyethylene terephthalate (PET), can be recycled many times. Signode's manufacturing plants recycle used PET strapping as well as post-consumer and post-industrial PET containers to make new Tenax® strapping.



Simple program requirements

1. Only 100% green PET strapping will be accepted for recycling.
2. Chop strap into 1/4" -3" long pieces. Place chopped strap in a bulk bin container (48" L x 48" W x 50" H max.) with a lid. Drums cannot be accepted.
3. Keep the container of used strapping free of other plastics, dirt, metal, paper and other contaminants.
4. Use plastic strapping (two straps minimum) to secure the container to a skid for shipment.
5. Signode will pay for truckload shipments of strapping over 20,000 lbs. For loads less than 20,000 lbs., shipper must pay freight to collection point.
